Red signifies divinity, and blue signifies humanity. Jesus wears red closest to Himself to show that He is a divine person. He received His humanity in time, so wears blue on top of the red. Conversely, Mary wears blue closest to herself because she is a human person. Red is worn over the blue to signify that she received her divinity second.

The three stars on Mary's forehead and shoulders refer to her virginity before, during, and after the birth of Christ.

The title at the top of the icon reads "Our Lady of Vladivostok" in Russian. The other letters in the icon are Greek. The letters MP mean "Mother of God." The letters ΘΥ stand for "Theotokos," or "God-bearer." The letters W and N in Christ's halo show that He is God. The letters IC stand for "Jesus," and the letters XC stand for "Christ."
